Attendance Requirements

Attend everything on timetable:

- Tutor Time – 8.45am every morning.
- Lessons.
- Private Study.
- Student Service.
- Intervention/support sessions.

Where possible, medical and dental appointments, driving lessons, etc. should be made before or after school (we do finish at 3.25pm!) or during free periods (**NOT** lessons or private study).

General Rule: If you would not take time off paid work, don't take time off school.

Attendance

Research by ALPS into attendance has confirmed the following:

If you compare students of equal 'ability':

- ▣ Those with attendance of **over 95%** will perform **one grade higher** per subject than those with an attendance of 85% or less.
- ▣ Each further **10% drop** in attendance causes a fall of another full grade per subject.

N.B. One week 'off' results in a 3% drop in attendance.

Absence Procedure

Unplanned Absence

- ▣ On the day of absence phone the Sixth Form office on **01423 798704** and leave a message.
- ▣ On return to school Students should collect a **pink** absence slip from your Form Tutor or the Sixth Form office, complete it in full and hand it in to your Form Tutor.

Planned Absence

- ▣ For an absence known about in advance, complete a **blue** form (available from your Form Tutor or the Sixth Form office) and hand it in to your Form Tutor at least **one week** in advance.

Or

- Royal Stewart Dress Tartan kilt with plain black tights.
- A **plain** white or cream shirt or blouse with a collar worn with a **plain** long sleeved jumper or cardigan in black, cream, red or grey (round or V-neck). They should not be of a large or patterned knit.
- A **plain** long sleeve Polo neck (high neck) jumper in black, cream, red or grey can be worn instead of the above shirt / jumper combination.
- **Plain** black shoes.

As with main school

- ▣ No facial or tongue piercings.
- ▣ Small/subtle earrings may be worn.
- ▣ No ear spacers, stretchers or expanders.
- ▣ No visible tattoos.
- ▣ No extreme hairstyles or hair colours.
- ▣ No outdoor clothing in main school or lessons.
