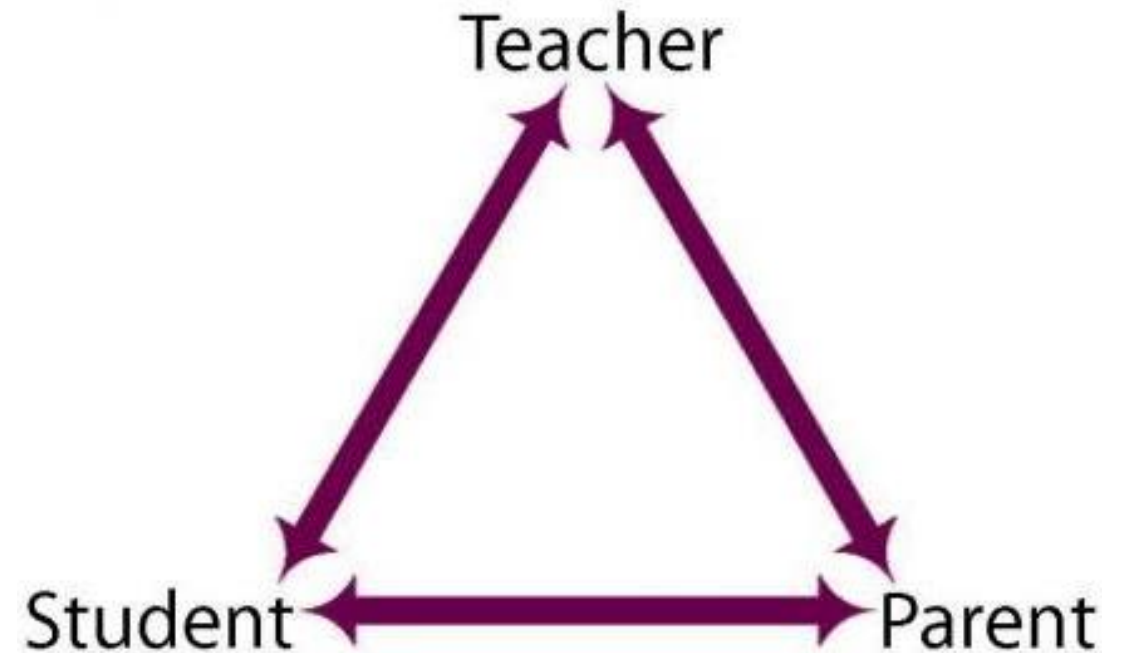

## Destinations - A great set of results!

59 YR13 students made UCAS applications

45 (76%) got into first choice universities

8 (14%) got into insurance choice universities

2 (3%) were placed through clearing

1 (1%) was placed through adjustment

3 (5%) withdrew their applications

Of the 56 students who have gone to university 21 (38%) have gone to a Russell Group University. One student going to study English at Cambridge.
