

SIXTH FORM AGREEMENT

Continuing your education Post-16 means that you are making a commitment to further study. King James's School is proud of its Sixth Form students and their successes. However, it does require taking responsibility for your own learning.

As a student you will undertake to;

- Arrive at lessons on time with a preparedness to work. This should include; having the correct equipment, books, folders, organiser and having completed any necessary homework.
- Strive to develop good independent study habits. This should include making productive use of study time; ensuring a good balance between paid work, socialising and school work (as a guide it is suggested that you work no more than 10 hours per week) and making use of an organiser.
- Support the ethos of the school that you have chosen to be part of. This should include contributing to the wider life of the school, maintaining the uniform and acting as a role model to younger pupils in all that you do.
- Have respect for the Sixth Form environment and the staff that work within it. This includes the caterers in the café, careers staff and secretarial staff.
- Communicate with your advisor and other pastoral staff to ensure that the correct level of support can be provided for you. This includes attending Advisor appointment times, returning administration promptly and working cooperatively with staff.
- Involve your Parents/Guardian in your education. They are providing support for you to be here!

As a school we will undertake to;

- Offer courses appropriate to your needs. This includes a broad and challenging curriculum delivered using a variety of teaching methods.
- Present opportunities for extra-curricular involvement in a number of different areas including; drama, music, sports and social trips.
- Deliver an appropriate programme of guidance in terms of health education, careers support and higher education guidance.
- Involve your Parents/Guardian in your education with the use of reports, parents' evenings and other communication if necessary.
- Provide appropriate support and encouragement.

As a Parent/Guardian you should undertake to:

- Inform school in the event of absence from school.
- Maintain communication with school about events that may affect the progress of your son/daughter.
- Work in conjunction with School to ensure the successful completion of your son/daughter's education.
- Be aware of the demands being placed on Sixth Form students from school, paid employment and friends.
