Lesson	Catch-Up Task:	Completed
1	You have just climbed up into your attic and, tucked away in the corner, you discover an old chest. Write a short, descriptive piece about what you find inside.	
2	Find a picture of a fairytale e.g. Little Red Riding Hood. Label the image with things you would be able to see, smell, hear, touch and taste if you were in this picture. Write up a short description using these senses.	
3	Research and write up a definition for each of these language devices: Simile, Metaphor, Personification, Onomatopoeia, Alliteration, Emotive Language, Repetition, Imagery.	
4	Find 'L5 Harry Potter extract' on Its Learning. Label the extract with everything we learn about Harry. Now, write up your own description of a made-up character. Include details about their appearance.

10	Create a colour thesaurus. Research synonyms for the following colours: red, green, blue, yellow, white, black, brown, orange. Write 3 sentences using your new colour synonyms.	
11	Find 'L12 Opening Lines' on Its Learning. Complete the worksheet.
