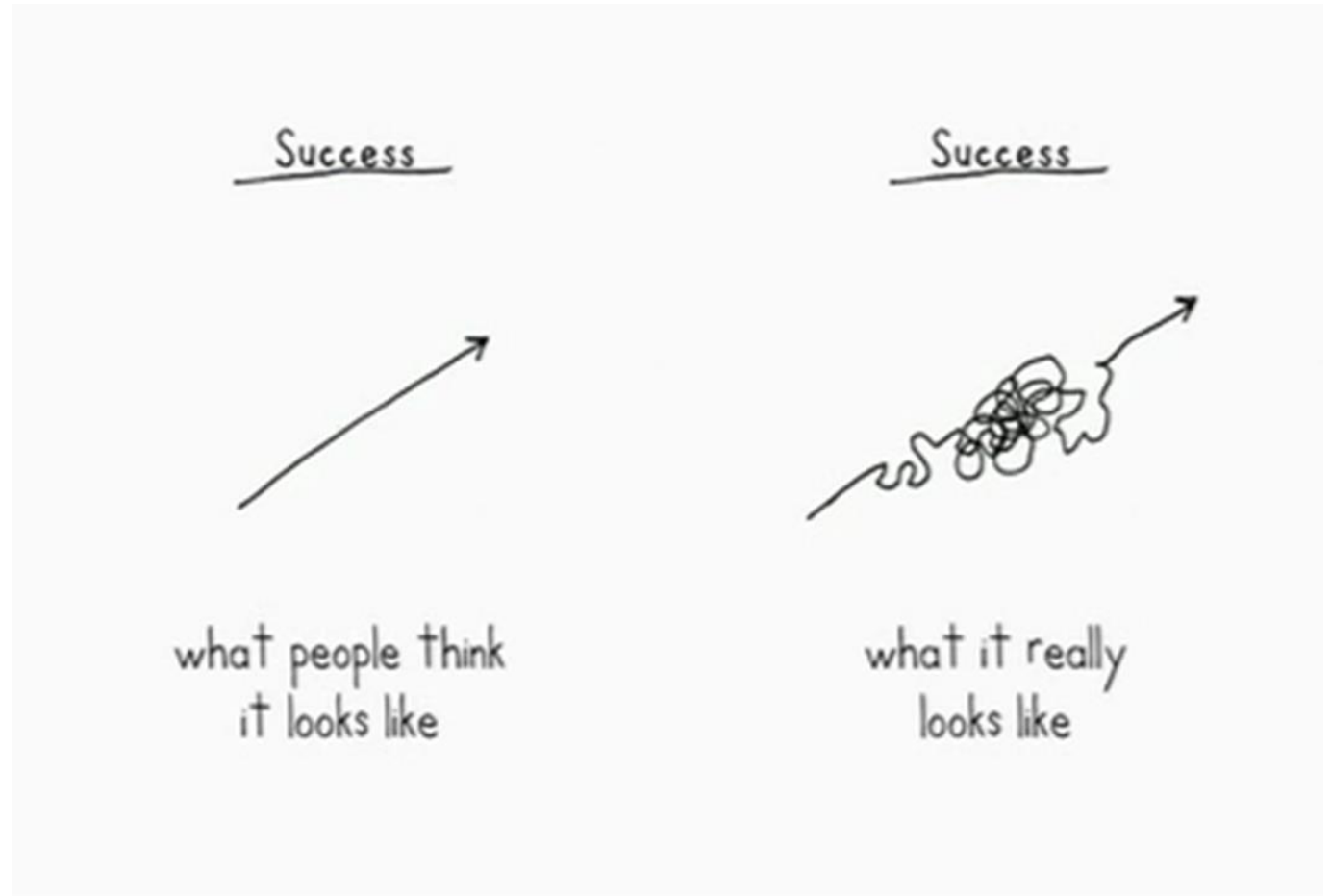
Home to School Travel Arrangements from September 2024

The Transition Timeline

June

- Pastoral staff visit every primary school
- Discussions with Y6 staff to gathering information

July

- 2 x Transition Days. Additional small schools & LS days
- Parents Evening to meet Form Tutor

Sept

- First Day of Term 'Y7 only Day'
- Year 7 Parents Support Evening to provide key information

Oct

- Year 7 Pastoral Parents Evening
- Discussion with Form Tutor about how they have settled in

What happens next?

- Deadline for Applications: 31 October 2024
- National offer day: 3 March 2025
- Travel arrangements for eligible pupils will be determined **only after** school place offers have been and travel requirements of all pupils are known
- This will include use of current routes/services as well as the identification of new contract requirements
