Revision Strategies								
Organising your notes by colour. Making flashcards (key quotes and ideas). Revising characters and tracing their 'journey' through a text. Revising key themes. Making mindmaps. Learning key quotations(!). Making quizzes and testing yourself. Completing a past paper (RevisionWorld.com). Mr Bruff/Mr Salles videos on YouTube. Reading a study guide (SNAP Revision; CGP etc). Online study guides: Sparknotes, YorkNotes, LitCharts etc). The <i>Pomodoro</i> method (look it up). Teach something to a friend. Group revision (test each other). Create your own past questions. Drafting paragraphs and self-checking. Timed writing practice. Reading and recording good vocabulary. Re-reading your set texts (skim read and pick out good moments and quotes).								
You might not be able to revise everything, but you need to try to revise as much as you can as you'll feel much more confident.
